Placement of Roadways onto The State Highway System Tooele County

Whereas, section 72-4-102 of the Utah Code 1998, provides for the Utah Transportation Commission to add to or delete highways from state highway system, and

Whereas, it has been determined by the Governor of the State of Utah and The Utah Department of Transportation, that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of the State of Utah, that a group of roadways described herein, residing within the boundaries of Tooele County be placed on the state highway system and designated as Statewide Public Safety Interest Highways, and

Whereas, this action will ensure the safety of the citizens of Utah by controlling the movement of nuclear waste materials along, across or parallel to State Highways,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

1. The Utah Transportation Commission designates the following as Statewide Public Safety Interest Highways:

(a) SR-900. From near the East bound on & off Ramps, of the I-80 Delle Interchange on the I-80 south frontage road, traversing northwesterly, westerly and northeasterly, including portions of a Tooele County and Bureau of Land Management road, a distance of $9.24 \pm$ miles. Then beginning again at the I-80 south frontage road, on a county road, traversing southwesterly and northwesterly a distance of $4.33 \pm$ miles. Then beginning again at the I-80 south frontage road, on a county and Bureau of Land Management road, traversing southwesterly, northwesterly, westerly and northeasterly to near the East bound on & off ramps of I-80 Low/Lakeside Interchange a distance of $2.61 \pm$ miles. The entire length of SR-900 is a total distance of $16.31\pm$ miles.

(b)SR-901. From SR-196 on a county road, traversing westerly and northwesterly to a junction with a Bureau of Land Management road described as SR-901, then northwesterly to a junction with a county road a distance of $8.70 \pm$ miles. Then beginning again at a junction with SR-901 described above on a Bureau of Land Management road traversing Northwesterly to a junction with a county road a distance of $6.52 \pm$ miles. Then beginning again at a junction with SR-901 described above on a Bureau of Land Management road traversing southwesterly to a junction with a county road a distance of $5.44 \pm$ miles. Then beginning again from a junction with SR-901 described above on a Bureau of Land Management road traversing southwesterly to a junction with SR-901 described above on a Bureau of Land Management road traversing southwesterly to a junction with a county road a distance of $5.44 \pm$ miles.
